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## Certificate II In Nail Technology (WRB20104)

An assessment will be given to decide if the student is eligible for RPL and if so the student will be exempt from the relevant modules.

## Claim for RPL

If the claim for RPL is supported by recognised original accredited documentation, the college is bound to recognise and accept the claim as presented. In some instances, the College may request that the student undertake an assessment of skills to confirm the level of attainment.
